Anti-ragging Policy

As per direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the Government has banned ragging completely in any form inside and outside of the campus and the Institute authorities are determined not to allow any form of the ragging. Therefore, at the time of admission, every student and his/her parents or Guardian shall be required to submit an affidavit that he/she submits himself/herself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Director and several authorities of the AIIMS who may be vested with the authority to exercise discipline under the Acts, the Statutes, the Rules and the rules that have been framed there under by competent authorities of AIIMS.

- 1) Ragging in all its forms is totally banned in the entire AIIMS complex including its departments, constituent units, all its premises (academic, residential, sports, canteen, etc.) whether located within the campus or outside and in all means of transportation of students whether public or private. The Medical College/Institution / University shall take strict action against those found guilty of ragging and/or of abetting ragging.
- 2) Any individual or collective act or practice or ragging constitute gross indiscipline shall be dealt with under this Rules.
- 3) As ragging takes place mostly in the hostels, hostel messes, and college canteens, especially after the classes are over in the college, round the clock vigil against ragging in the hostel premises shall be provided. Also, the employers/employees of the canteens/mess and the security personnel posted in hostels shall be given necessary instructions to keep strict vigil and to report the incidents of ragging to the college authorities if any.
- 4) Ragging for the purposes of this rules, ordinarily means any act, conduct or practice by which dominant power or status of senior students is brought to bear on students freshly enrolled or students who are, in any way, considered junior or inferior by other students and includes individual or collective acts or practice which:
 - a. Involve physical assault or threat or use of physical force
 - b. Violate the status, dignity and honour of women students
 - c. Violate the status; dignity and honour of students belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Castes
 - d. Expose students to ridicule and contempt and affect their self-esteem
 - e. Entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gesture and obscene behavior
- 5) The Anti-ragging committee of AIIMS shall take immediate action on any information of the occurrence of ragging.

- 6) Notwithstanding anything in Clause (5) above, the Dean (Academics) or any other Faculty member/or authority may also suo moto enquire into any incident of ragging and make a report to the Anti-ragging committee of the identity of those who have engaged and the nature of the incident.
- 7) The Dean (Academics) or Hostel Superintendent may also submit an initial report establishing the identity of the perpetrators of ragging and the nature of the ragging incident.
- 8) On the receipt of a report under clause (6) or (7) or a determination by the relevant authority disclosing the occurrence or ragging incidents described in the Clause 4(a), (b) and (c) the Anti-ragging committee shall recommend rustication of a student or students for a specific number of semester.
- 9) The Anti-ragging committee may in other cases of ragging shall recommend that any student or students be expelled or be not, for a stated period, admitted to a course of study as AIIMS, departmental examination for one or more semesters or that the result of the student or students concerned in the examination(s) in which they appeared be cancelled.
- 10) For the purpose of this Rules, abetment to ragging will also amount to ragging.
- 11) In case of any discrepancy between these rules and Government of India Policy, the GOI policy will prevail.

What constitutes Ragging ?

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- 1) any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
- 2) indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
- 3) asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
- 4) any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- 5) exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- 6) any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- 7) any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- 8) any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
- 9) any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Punishable ingredients of Ragging:

- a) Abetment of ragging.
- b) Criminal conspiracy of ragging.
- c) Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging.
- d) Public nuisance created during ragging.
- e) Violation of decency and morals through ragging.
- f) Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt.
- g) Wrongful restraint.
- h) Wrongful confinement.
- i) Use of criminal force
- j) Assault as well as sexual offences or even unnatural offences.
- k) Extortion.
- l) Criminal trespass.
- m) Offences against property.
- n) Criminal Intimidation.
- o) Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s).
- p) Physical or psychological humiliation.
- q) All other offences following from the definition of "Ragging".

Awardable Punishments:

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- i. Fine of Rs. 25,000/- to Rs. 1 lakh.
- ii. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- iii. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- iv. Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process
- v. Withholding results
- vi. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- vii. Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel
- viii. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters

ix. Cancellation of admission

x. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period

Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

Departmental disciplinary action against any member or staff

Where in the opinion of the appointing authority, a lapse is attributable to any member of the faculty or staff of the institution, in the matter of reporting or taking prompt action to prevent an incident of ragging or who display an apathetic or insensitive attitude towards complaints of ragging, or who fail to take timely steps, whether required under these Regulations or otherwise, to prevent an incident or incidents of ragging, then such authority shall initiate departmental disciplinary action, in accordance with the prescribed procedure of the institution, against such member of the faculty or staff. Provided that where such lapse is attributable to the Head of the institution, the authority designated to appoint such Head shall take such departmental disciplinary action; and such action shall be without prejudice to any action that may be taken under the penal laws for abetment of ragging for failure to take timely steps in the prevention of ragging or punishing any student found guilty of ragging.

Anti-ragging Measures

All India Institute of Medical Sciences – Bilaspur, Himachal Pradesh adopts zero tolerance towards ragging and harbors a ragging free campus. Strict anti-ragging measures are in vogue which includes,

- 1) Anti-ragging committee with representatives from senior faculty, MBBS students, parents of MBBS students and external members.
- 2) Anti-ragging squad duty with strict vigil round the clock.
- 3) Anti-ragging banners containing contact numbers to report incidents of ragging will be displayed in multiple locations.
- 4) Employment and sensitization of guards in multiple locations to prevent the incidents of ragging
- 5) All employees of AIIMS-Bilaspur are sensitized to report incidents of ragging immediately and to submit an undertaking for curbing the menace of ragging in this campus.
- 6) Anti-ragging affidavits are signed by parents and students during the time of admission.
- 7) Students are made to register online in recommended anti-ragging websites (antiragging.in/ amanmovement.org).
- 8) Sensitization programs to junior and senior students by professional counsellors, faculty and external guest who befit the context.
- 9) Resident counselor program (RCP) which encourages student faculty interactions is in vogue. This provides a congenial promotive environment for the fresher students to quickly adapt to the new environment.
- 10) Orientation programs to make fresher students to become independent and self sufficient during times of emergency or need.
- 11) Vigil on the students especially freshers during all events of interaction of batches in the campus (such as during celebration, functions, sports or other co-curricular & extracurricular activities)
- 12) Distancing seniors from freshers in the campus especially the hostel and mess.
- 13) Concerned faculty to ensure fresher is never alone in classrooms or times the other than stipulated teaching hours (for rehearsal, preparation of an event etc)
- 14) Strict enforcement of General code of conduct of hostel
- 15) Disciplinary action on freshers not reporting the incidents of ragging, either as victims or as witnesses

Duties of the Anti-Ragging Squads

- 1) The Anti-Ragging Squads to be called upon to make surprise raids on hostels, and other places vulnerable to incidents of; and having the potential of, ragging and shall be empowered to inspect such places.
- 2) The Anti-Ragging Squads to conduct an on-the-spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it by the Head of the institution or any member of the faculty or any member of the staff or any student or any parent or guardian or any employee of a service provider or by any other person, as the case may be; and the enquiry report along with recommendations shall be submitted to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action.
- 3) The Anti-Ragging Squads will be on duty from morning 9 AM to 9 AM (next day) on the allocated duty day and they are required to daily submit report of rounds/visit on prescribed format to the Registrar (Academics) Member Secretary, Anti-Ragging Committee/Monitoring Cell for further necessary action.
