Laparoscopic/Open Gastrointestinal surgeries, splenectomy.</li> <li>2. Breast surgeries (benign/malignant)</li> <li>3. Varicose vein's surgeries (SEPS/SFJ ligation)</li> <li>4. Laparoscopic/open Abdominal wall hernia surgeries</li> <li>5. Laparoscopic repair of Hiatal Hernias (fundoplication)</li> <li>6. Laparoscopic Bariatric Surgery (to be functional)</li> <li>7. Head and neck surgeries (thyroid, parotid)</li> <li>8. Stapler Haemorrhoidectomy (MIPH)</li> <li>9. Minimally invasive surgery for fistula ano</li> </ol> <p><b>Emergency OT</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Acute abdomen surgeries</li> <li>2. Limb Amputations (trauma/gangrene)</li> <li>3. Abdominal and chest trauma management</li> <li>4.
